



## AP and IB CALCULUS CREDIT

Students who earned passing scores on AP Calculus in high school will receive credit for certain OSU courses. Students who receive scores of AB-1, AB-2, BC-1 or BC-2 will receive no credit. These students will need to complete the **OSU Math Placement Test** and schedule in accordance with it.

**International Baccalaureate (IB) 2021 onward: No credit for any exam.**

4-5	1151	1151 or 1156, 1152 or 1172 (1181H or 4181H with advisor approval)
6-7	1151*	1152 or 1172, 2153 (1181H or 4181H with advisor approval)

\* Students who receive a 6 or 7 on the IB HL exam may be eligible for additional credit in addition to Math 1151 (Calculus I). Students should contact the Math Advising Office during orientation to determine if they are eligible for additional credit and thus what courses they will be permitted to enroll.

\*\* The rule of thumb for any student taking AP, IB, post-secondary including at OSU is that the student is permitted to retake the highest course for which he has credit. Any request outside these guidelines needs a written petition. Schedules may need to be adjusted once actual scores have arrived.
