

AU26 Spirit Week Door Decorating Contest

Official Rules

1. DO NOT GLUE (OR PAINT OR NAIL OR OTHERWISE PERMANENTLY AFFIX) ANYTHING TO THE DOORS OR WALLS!
2. The door still needs to be able to open and close completely, lock, etc.
3. Do not obscure hallways, etc. If your door contains a window, it must remain primarily uncovered.
4. You need to sign up and claim a theme for your door; it has to be a theme not already claimed by someone else!
5. Only three people can officially compete per door (due to funding restrictions), but any number of people can contribute to decorating your door. You can agree to share the prizes, but we will only be providing a maximum of three per winning door.
6. The door you decorate does not need to be for *your* office, but it does need to be an office and you do need the office's occupants' permission!
7. The decorations should have the potential to remain up for a year (so things like balloons, post-its, etc. are a poor choice).
8. You can decorate the inside of the door, but only the view from outside will be considered.
9. The winning doors will be decided by popular vote on October 23.

Decorating Suggestions/Resources

- On Monday, October 19th, from 1:00-5:00 PM in MW 724, there will be a tea time with some supplies available.
- Use items like strong tape, magnets (for metal doors), and removable wallpaper to attach decorations to the door.
- Use stickers and construction/butcher paper to apply color to the door.
- The resource room in the Ohio Union has decorating items that are free to use including paints, colored papers, tape, etc.
- The resource room also has the ability to print posters, stickers, and various other things for purchase.
- Cycle has a 3D printer which can be used. MGSA has a small quantity of filament which you can use, or you can provide your own for large quantities/custom colors.
- BAMM has a cricut which can be used (must provide your own vinyl/stickers/etc.).
- There are various makerspaces around campus (such as the one in Bolz hall) with tools and supplies.
